7.1.10 Endorsements, Referrals and Bail

- A. Officers shall not recommend or suggest, except in transaction of their personal business, the employment or procurement of a particular product, professional service, or commercial service (such as an attorney, ambulance service, towing service, private investigator, mortician, etc.). In the case of ambulance or towing service, when such service is necessary and the person needing the service is unable or unwilling to procure it or requests assistance, officers shall use their discretion and call any ambulance or towing service available at the time.
- B. Officers, other than the Chief of Police or designee, shall not endorse any license or pistol permit application wherein their official title or occupation is indicated. Use of title or occupation could be misinterpreted as official sanction or recommendation of the officer in his/her official capacity as a member of this Department.
- C. Officers shall not recommend or suggest a bondsman or attorney for any person arrested. Officers are not permitted to furnish bail or sign bond for any person arrested by this Department.
