7.1.14 Intervention

- A. Officers shall not interfere with cases being handled by other officers of the Department or by any other governmental agency unless:
 - 1. Ordered to intervene by a superior officer, or
 - 2. The intervening officer believes beyond a reasonable doubt that a manifesting injustice would result from failure to take immediate action.

- B. Officers shall not undertake any investigation or other official action not part of their regular duties without obtaining permission from their superior officer unless the exigency of the situation requires immediate police action.
