

East Norriton Township – Special Meeting – Zoom
August 11, 2020

The Special Meeting of the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township was held via Zoom. The meeting was called to order by Chairman McDevitt at 7:04 p.m. on Tuesday, August 11, 2020.

Roll call was taken: Finance Director, David Crist, Assistant Township Manager, Jeff Winterbottom, Township Manager, Robert Hart, Vice Chairwoman, Amanda Cappelletti, Supervisor, Ashley DiPiero, Supervisor, Joseph Gavanus, Chairman, Kevin McDevitt and Township Solicitor, Alex Baumler were present for the Zoom meeting. Supervisor Dennis DeSanto was absent.

Chairman McDevitt reviewed that the purpose of tonight's Special Meeting was due to the recent resignation of East Norriton Township's Tax Collector, Kate Gillen.

Chairman McDevitt called on Township Manager, Robert Hart to review this item. Mr. Hart outlined that Kate Gillen resigned from her elected position of Tax Collector effective July 17, 2020. According to the ordinance the Board of Supervisors has thirty days from the date of resignation to appoint a Tax Collector. Prior to her resignation Mrs. Gillen deputized the Township to collect the Township and County taxes only. Taxes can now be paid at the Township. The appointee tonight will serve until the November election and then the newly elected Tax Collector will take over in January 2021.

Chairman McDevitt announced that the Township will be appointing Rose Marie McCloy a long-time resident of East Norriton Township. Supervisor Gavanus stated that Ms. McCloy is very qualified candidate for the position. Township Manager, Robert Hart reviewed that Ms. McCloy has a long history of serving on boards and committees from church related to civic groups and Ms. McCloy also has a real estate background.

Ms. McCloy stated that she is very thankful for being nominated by the East Norriton Township Board of Supervisors and that she is looking forward to helping the Township.


Chairman McDevitt made a motion to appoint Rose Marie McCloy as the East Norriton Township Tax Collector. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Gavanus and approved unanimously.

Chairman McDevitt asked if there were any citizens to be heard, Mr. Crist reported that there were none.

Chairman McDevitt called on Township Manager, Robert Hart for Manager's Update. Mr. Hart commented on a letter that residents are receiving from Aqua who has recently taken over the Township sewer system. When Aqua decides to purchase new additional sewer systems they are required to notify their current clients. The letter explains that Aqua is attempting to purchase a Delaware County sewer system. Further in the letter Aqua explains it that cannot increase East Norriton Township resident's sewer rates until a rate case is submitted to the Pennsylvania Public Utilities Commission (PUC). Mr. Hart stated that the rate will remain the same for approximately the next two to three years.

Chairman McDevitt made a motion to adjourn the Zoom meeting at 7:14 p.m.; the motion was seconded by Vice Chairwoman Cappelletti and approved unanimously.
