RESOLUTION FOR PLAN REVISION

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF PLYMOUTH TOWNSHIP, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA (hereinafter “the municipality”).

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537, known as the “Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act,” as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) adopted thereunder, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, requires the municipality to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of the municipality, and

WHEREAS, East Norriton Township has prepared a report titled, “Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan Special Study for East Norriton Township,” (Facility Plan) which addresses purchase of the sanitary wastewater collection system in East Norriton Township by Aqua Pennsylvania Wastewater, Inc. (AQUA), including assignment of the Township’s rights and obligations in all relevant agreements to AQUA; and


WHEREAS, an intermunicipal agreement exists between Plymouth Township and East Norriton Township, dated August 13, 1991, which addresses the acceptance of sewage from properties outside of each respective municipality into their sewer mains, trunk lines, outfall sewers and pumping stations and to convey through their respective collection systems any sanitary sewage received under the terms of that agreement to the East Norriton-Plymouth-Whitpain Joint Sewer Authority sewage treatment facility; and

WHEREAS the selected sewage disposal alternative to be implemented is the sale of East Norriton Township’s sanitary wastewater collection system to AQUA, including assignment all of the rights and obligations associated with said intermunicipal agreement, from East Norriton Township to AQUA; and

WHEREAS, Plymouth Township finds that the Facility Plan described above conforms to applicable zoning, subdivision, other municipal ordinances and plans and to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of Plymouth Township hereby adopts and submits to the Department of Environmental Protection for its approval as a revision to the “Official Plan” of the municipality, the above referenced Facility Plan. The municipality hereby assures the Department of the complete and timely implementation of the said plan as required by law. (Section 5, Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act as amended).




