

East Norriton Township – Regular Meeting
June 25, 2019

The Regular Meeting of the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township was called to order by Chairman McDevitt at 7:01 p.m. on Tuesday, June 25, 2019, at the Township Municipal Building. Supervisors present were Kevin McDevitt, Amanda Cappelletti, Dennis DeSanto Jr., and Joseph Gavanus Jr. Ashley DiPiero was absent.

After roll call, the Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all in attendance.

Chairman McDevitt announced that the Board of Supervisors met earlier this evening in Executive Session to discuss matters of litigation and personnel.

Chairman McDevitt introduced the next item on the agenda, Approval of Meeting Minutes. Vice Chairwoman Cappelletti made a motion to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of May 28, 2019. The motion was seconded by Supervisor DeSanto and approved unanimously.

Chairman McDevitt introduced the next item on the agenda, Finance Reports. Supervisor DeSanto made a motion to approve the Finance Reports for May 2019. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Gavanus and approved unanimously.

Chairman McDevitt introduced the next item on the agenda, Township Reports. Vice Chairwoman Cappelletti made a motion to approve the Township Reports for May 2019. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Gavanus and approved unanimously.

Chairman McDevitt asked if there were any citizens to be heard; there were none.

Chairman McDevitt asked if there were any comments from the Board of Supervisors. Supervisor DeSanto commented about a social media page on a young man, Jake, dealing with autism that just graduated from NAHS. Supervisor DeSanto congratulated Jake.

Supervisor Gavanus introduced the first item on the agenda under "Old Business", Consideration of Authorizing Notice of Intent to Award for the Norris City Avenue Sewer Project. Director of Engineering Services, Jim Sullivan reviewed that bids were received on June 18, 2019. Doli Construction Corporation with their bid in the amount of \$241,629.00, was the apparent low bidder. Mr. Sullivan recommended that the Board of Supervisors authorize the issuance of the Notice of Intent to Award to Doli Construction Corporation. The final award will be dependent on the successful outcome of the responsible contractor determination which will be issued approximately thirty days after the Notice of Intent to Award. Chairman McDevitt made a motion to authorize the Notice of Intent to Award to Doli Construction Corporation. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Gavanus and approved unanimously.

Vice Chairwoman Cappelletti introduced the first item on the agenda under, “New Business”, Authorize the Purchase of Playground Equipment. Township Manger, Robert Hart reviewed the playground equipment and foundation to be used at Heroes Park located on North Wales Road. The equipment is being purchased through a grant and will cost approximately \$120,000.00 from Recreation Resource USA, a Costars approved company. Installation of Phase One should begin in August, 2019. Vice Chairwoman questioned if children in wheel chairs or other medical equipment will be able to utilize this facility. Mr. Hart stated that they will be able to and that the Township is looking into special swings for Phase Two of this project. Vice Chairwoman Cappelletti made a motion to authorize the purchase of the equipment. The motion was seconded by Supervisor DeSanto and approved unanimously.

Chairman McDevitt read Schedule of Meetings from June 26, 2019 through July 23, 2019.

Chairman McDevitt introduced the next item on the agenda, “Other Business”. There was none.

Chairman McDevitt called on Township Manager, Robert Hart for the Manger’s Update. Mr. Hart reviewed the remote access features currently being installed; summer camp has begun and on Wednesday, June 26th *The Sensational Soul Cruisers* will be performing as part of the Township’s Concerts in the Park series. Sergeant Thomas Douglas reported on Cop Camp that took place the week of June 17th.

Chairman McDevitt asked if there were any residents who wished to speak; Sue McLaughlin of 2926 N. Whitehall Road stated that tonight was *The Time Herald* reporter, Andrea Grabenstein’s last meeting. The Board of Supervisors thanked Ms. Grabenstein for her diligent work and wished her well with her new endeavor.

Vice Chairwoman Cappelletti made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:20 p.m.; the motion was seconded by Supervisor Gavanus and approved unanimously.
