

ORDINANCE #5

TO PROVIDE FOR THE HEALTH, CLEANLINESS, COMFORT AND SAFETY OF THE CITIZENS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST NORRITON, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, BY PROHIBITING THE ESTABLISHMENT OR CONDUCTING OF ANY PIGGERY IN SAID TOWNSHIP

The Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, under and by virtue of the authority of the Second Class Township Code, does hereby ORDAIN AND ENACT:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to set up, establish, conduct or maintain any piggery in said Township of East Norriton in any manner whatsoever.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful to permit any accumulation of garbage, manure or refuse from any piggery on any private or public property, vacant or occupied, within the Township of East Norriton.

Section 3. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof, shall forfeit and pay a fine of not exceeding \$300.00 to the Township of East Norriton, the same to be collected by summary proceedings brought in the name of the Township before any Justice of the Peace of said Township. A new and separate offense shall be deemed to be committed for each day that such violation exists. In default of the payment of any fine or penalty imposed, and the costs, under the provisions of this ordinance, the person or persons so charged may be sentenced and committed to the County Jail for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days.
