

ORDINANCE NO. 117

AN ORDINANCE GIVING CERTAIN POLICE POWERS TO  
EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP ENFORCEMENT OFFICIALS

The Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, hereby ordain and enact as follows:

Section 1. The East Norriton Township Building Inspector, Fire Marshal, Zoning Officer and Plumbing Inspector are hereby granted such police powers as may be necessary to file complaints, informations and citations before the appropriate District Justice. The purpose of this grant of powers is to comply with recent amendments to the Rules of Criminal Procedure.

Section 2. The grant of the above power to the above-named East Norriton Township officials shall not in any way be deemed to confer upon them any rights, duties or obligations of police officers of East Norriton Township with the exception of those powers necessary to properly administer their Township functions. They shall not be considered policemen under the terms of the Police Tenure Act, or any other statute, ordinance, rule or regulation dealing with terms and conditions of employment, illness or retirement.
