

ORDINANCE NO. 119

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A COST OF LIVING INCREASE IN THE RETIREMENT PAY OF FORMER POLICE CHIEF JAMES A. OLIVER WHO WAS RETIRED FROM THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP FOR REASONS OF SERVICE CONNECTED PERMANENT DISABILITY UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF ORDINANCE NO. 114

WHEREAS, former Police Chief James A. Oliver was retired from the Police Department of East Norriton Township by reason of service connected permanent disability effective January 1, 1974, under the authority of Ordinance No. 114; and

WHEREAS, the cost of living index for the Philadelphia Metropolitan Area as maintained and published by the United States Department of Labor indicates an increase in the cost of living of 12.6% as of January 21, 1975 for the yearly period January 1, 1974 through December 31, 1974; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 113 provides the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township with the authority for providing cost of living increases for retired members of the East Norriton Township Police Department.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED that a cost of living increase in the amount of 12.6% of current retirement pay be authorized for former Police Chief James A. Oliver, effective July 1, 1975.
