EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE "EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP
ZONING ORDINANCE OF 1963" (ORDINANCE NO. 40 AS AMENDED
AND REVISED BY ORDINANCE NO. 96) BY CHANGING THE
REQUIREMENTS FOR SIGNS IN THE SHOPPING CENTER DISTRICT

The Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, under and by virtue of authority granted by the Second Class Township Code and the Municipalities Planning Code, do hereby enact and ordain:

Section 1. Delete Section 1703 and insert therein a new Section 1703 containing the following language:

Section 1703. Signs permitted in Shopping Center District.

1. One free-standing sign advertising the shopping center which may include a directory of stores in the shopping center, having no more than two (2) sides, each of which shall not exceed one hundred fifty (150) square feet in area and shall not be more than thirty (30) feet in height.
2. One (1) sign attached to the frontage of each store within the shopping center having a maximum dimensions of one (1) square foot for every one (1) foot of building frontage. Such signs shall not exceed four (4) feet in height.
