

ORDINANCE NO. 132

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 124 PERMITTING AND REGULATING THE USE OF HOLDING TANKS FOR CERTAIN RESIDENTIAL, COMMERCIAL OR INDUSTRIAL SANITARY AND SEWAGE PURPOSES IN THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST NORRITON, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AND DESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS.

The Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township hereby enacts and ordains the following changes to Ordinance No. 124:

- I. Section 1. Intent is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced by the following:

Section 1. Intent. The intent of this Ordinance is to establish procedures for the use and maintenance of holding tanks designed to receive and retain sewage from certain residential, commercial or industrial uses, and it is hereby declared that the enactment of this Ordinance is necessary for the protection, benefit and preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of this Township during the time that a connection ban imposed by the Environmental Protection Agency is in effect.


- II. Section 2. Definition

C. Definition for "Improved Property" is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced by the following:

C. "Improved Property" shall mean any property within the Township upon which there is erected a residential, commercial or industrial structure intended for continuous or periodic occupancy or use by human beings or animals, and from which structure sewage shall or may be discharged and which would ordinarily be served by public sanitary sewers, but for the sewer connection ban imposed by the Environmental Protection Agency.


