

ORDINANCE NO. 47

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE OWNER OR CUSTODIAN OF ANIMALS OF THE CLASS OF BEASTS OF BURDEN AND CATTLE TO CONTROL AND RESTRAIN SUCH ANIMALS FROM LEAVING THE OWNER'S OR CUSTODIAN'S PREMISES AND ROAM AT LARGE IN EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the incidence of horses running at large, unattended and unrestrained, over the highways and roads of East Norriton Township and private property of the citizens thereof, has increased, thereby endangering the health and safety of persons and causing nuisances and damage to property and which therefore is a proper subject of regulation and prohibition under said Township Police Power:

The Supervisors of East Norriton Township hereby enact as follows:

Section 1. After the effective date of this Ordinance, it shall be unlawful for the owner or custodian of any cattle, horses, donkeys, borros or any other beasts of burden, to permit such animals to leave the premises of said owner or custodian and traverse the roads and highways in said Township or to wander upon or across property of the citizens of said Township unattended and without proper and necessary restraint and control. It shall be the duty of said owner or the custodian of said animals

to provide such measures as will control and restrain said animals upon the premises so that they do not cause or threaten to cause danger to the health and safety of the citizens of said Township or cause or threaten to cause damage to property within said Township.

Section 2. Any person or persons violating this Ordinance shall upon being adjudged guilty in any proceeding brought by virtue hereof before any Justice of the Peace having jurisdiction within said Township, be sentenced to pay a fine, for the use of said Township, of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00), for each offense, and in default of paying said fine and all costs accrued, shall be committed to the County Jail for a period not exceeding five (5) days.
