

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CONSIDER PASSAGE OF AN ORDINANCE FURTHER
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 43

ORDINANCE NO. 48

OF THE

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF
THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST NORRITON
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PA.

AMENDING ORDINANCE 43 DULY ENACTED BY THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST NORRITON ON MONDAY NOVEMBER 1, 1965. AS TO SECTION 2-C DEFINITIONS, SECTION 7, ADDING PARAGRAPH E TO ARTICLE 11, SECTION 11.1 OF THE FIRE PREVENTION CODE, ADDING PARAGRAPH D TO ARTICLE 14, SECTION 14.6 OF THE FIRE PREVENTION CODE, AMENDING ARTICLE 28, SECTION 28.1 D OF THE FIRE PREVENTION CODE.

The Board of Supervisors of the Township of East Norriton, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, does hereby enact and ordain as follows:

Section 2-C Definitions of Ordinance 43 shall be altered, changed and amended to read as follows:

"Section 2 - Definitions

Wherever the words "Chief of the Bureau of Fire Prevention" are used in the Fire Prevention Code, they shall be held to mean the duly appointed Fire Marshal of East Norriton Township and/or the duly appointed Deputy Fire Marshal and/or the Fire Chief of East Norriton Township."

Section 7 shall be altered changed and amended to read as follows:

"Section 7. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of the Code hereby adopted or fail to comply therewith, or who shall violate or fail to comply with any order made thereunder, or who shall build in violation of any detailed statement of specifications or plans submitted and approved thereunder, or any certificate or permit issued thereunder, and from which no appeal has been taken or who shall fail to comply with such an order as affirmed or modified by the Supervisors or by a court of competent jurisdiction, within the time fixed herein, shall severally for each and every such violation and noncompliance upon summary conviction, before a Justice of Peace be sentenced to pay a fine of

not more than one hundred (\$100.00) Dollars or in default of payment thereof by imprisonment for not more than five (5) days. The imposition of one (1) penalty for any violation shall not excuse the violation or permit it to continue; and all such persons shall be required to correct or remedy such violations or defects within a reasonable time; and when not otherwise specified each day that prohibited conditions are maintained shall constitute a separate offense.

The applications of the above penalty shall not be held to prevent the enforced removal of prohibited conditions.

There shall be added to Article 11, Section 11.1 of the Fire Prevention Code a new Paragraph E which shall read as follows:

"Article 11. Section 11.1 Paragraph E. All existing exits shall be unlocked and unobstructed during hours such occupancy is open to the public."

There shall be added to Article 14, Section 14.6 of the Fire Prevention Code a new Paragraph (D) which shall read as follows:


"Article 14, Section 14.6 Paragraph D. All commercial and industrial establishments, mercantile, educational and institutional occupancy, places of assembly, hotel, motel and multi-family dwellings shall be equipped with suitable fire detecting devices such as automatic fire alarm systems, automatic sprinkler or water spray system or standpipe and hose, as specified by the Chief of the Bureau of Fire Prevention. "


Article 28, Section 28.1 (d) of the Fire Prevention Code shall be amended to read as follows:

"Article 28, Section 28.1 (d) - Chief of the bureau of Fire Prevention may prohibit any or all bonfires and outdoor rubbish fires when atmospheric conditions or local circumstances make such fires hazardous."
