

ORDINANCE NO. 65

AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE FIRE PREVENTION CODE
AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 43, ORDINANCE NO. 48, AND
ORDINANCE NO. 53, IN REFERENCE TO ILLEGAL PARKING

The Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township, Montgomery
County, Pa., hereby enact and ordain as follows:

The Fire Prevention Code as adopted in Ordinance No. 43,
supplemented and amended by Sec. 7 of the same, which Section
7 was amended by Ordinances 48 and 53 is hereby further sup-
plemented and amended by adding to the first paragraph of
Section 7 the following:-

Except that in all cases involving the illegal parking
of motor vehicles under the provisions of Article 11, Sec.11.5,
where the proper officer shall first give notice of the offense
by either handing to the offending driver, or other person
responsible for parking the motor vehicle, or affixing to the
car or vehicle in question a ticket on which he has noted the
time and place and nature of the offense charged, no
prosecution shall be instituted for 48 hours thereafter.
During such 48-hour period, such violator may, within the 48-
hour period, pay at the office of the Township Treasurer, or
send by mail postmarked within 48 hours of the violation, as
a penalty for and in full satisfaction of such violation, the
sum of \$5.00. Failure of the violator to make payment as
aforesaid shall render such violator subject to penalties
generally for all violations of Ordinance No. 43, as sup-
plemented and amended as set forth in Section 7.
