

ORDINANCE NO. 80

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SNOW REMOVAL ORDINANCE  
OF EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP BEING ORDINANCE NO.  
69

The Supervisors of East Norriton Township hereby ordain and enact as follows:

WHEREAS, during periods of heavy snowfalls the movement of fire equipment may be impeded as a result of the failure on the part of owners of apartment complexes to provide snow removal; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed in the best interests of the residents of East Norriton Township and necessary to insure the health and safety of the public in East Norriton Township;

It is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

Section 1 of Ordinance No. 69 is hereby amended to read as follows:


It shall be unlawful for any owner or lessee of any property to allow or permit snow or ice to lie upon, remain upon, or be piled or accumulated upon a sidewalk, upon which such property abuts within the Township for more than 24 hours. It shall further be unlawful for any owner of an apartment to allow or permit snow or ice to lie upon, remain upon, or be piled or accumulated upon any walkway used by residents of the apartment or upon any paved surface used for ingress, egress or parking of motor vehicles for more than 24 hours.

Section 2 of Ordinance No. 69 is hereby amended to read as follows:

It shall be the duty of the property owner or the lessee of the same not later than 24 hours after snow has ceased to fall to clear or cause to be cleared a pathway in the sidewalk upon which said property abuts. Such pathway shall not be less than 30 inches in width and shall be thoroughly cleaned to that extent of snow and ice or other obstruction. It shall be the duty of the owner of any apartment within the East Norriton Township not later than 24 hours after snow has ceased to fall to clear or cause to be cleared a pathway in any walkway within the apartment complex. Such pathway shall be not less than 30 inches in width and shall be thoroughly cleaned to that extent of snow and ice or other obstruction. It shall be the duty of the owner of any apartment within East Norriton Township not later than 24 hours

after snow has ceased to fall to clear or cause to be cleared any paved surface used for ingress, egress or parking of motor vehicles. Such paved surface shall be thoroughly cleaned of snow and ice or other obstruction.
