
AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST NORRITON,
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROHIBITING THE
PARKING OF CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLES ON THE HIGHWAYS
OF EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, the parking and storage of commercial equipment and vehicles on the highways of East Norriton Township is deemed by the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township to constitute a hazard to the health and safety of the residents of East Norriton Township;


NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of East Norriton, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, does hereby ordain as follows:

- Section 1. No commercial equipment including trucks (in excess of one ton capacity), tandems, tractor trailers, tractors or other commercial or construction or cargo moving vehicles or equipment shall be, under any conditions, parked or stored upon any highway or street or portion of any highway or street, up to the full width of the legal right of way, within the Township of East Norriton.
- Section 2. This ordinance shall not apply to commercial equipment and vehicles actually in present use for a lawful purpose such as delivery of goods, rendering of services or construction of improvements provided such equipment and vehicles are removed from the highways or streets at the end of each working day.
- Section 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of \$10 for the first offense, \$25 for the second offense, and \$50 for any subsequent offense, plus costs of prosecution and in default of payment thereof shall undergo imprisonment for not more than five days. Each day shall constitute a separate offense.
- Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
