

ORDINANCE NO. 99

AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THAT A QUESTION CONCERNING THE FORM OF GOVERNMENT OF EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP BE PLACED ON THE BALLOT FOR DECISION BY THE VOTERS OF EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP.

WHEREAS, the Government Study Group appointed by the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township to study the various alternative forms of government available to East Norriton Township has recommended that the Board of Supervisors place on the ballot the question of whether or not the Board of Supervisors should be increased from three to five members; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors believes that the Government Study Group has carefully and thoroughly reviewed the various forms of government available to East Norriton Township;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township hereby enact and ordain as follows:

SECTION I - The following question shall be placed on the ballot for the primary election to be held in May of 1974 or as soon thereafter as is permissible by law:

"Should the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township adopt an Ordinance increasing the Board of Supervisors from the present three members to five members?

SECTION II - The Township Manager and Township Solicitor are hereby authorized and directed to take whatever steps are necessary to implement the requirements of this Ordinance.
