

ORDINANCE NO. 160

East Norriton Township
Montgomery County, Pennsylvania

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE CONSUMPTION OF
ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN CERTAIN PLACES WITHIN
THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST NORRITON AND PRESCRIBING
PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

The Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township,
Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, under and by virtue of authority
granted by the Second Class Township Code, do hereby enact and
ordain:

Section 1.

It shall be unlawful for any person to consume any
alcoholic beverage and/or malt brew as defined in the Pennsylvania
Liquor Code or to possess any such beverage with the intent to con-
sume the same, while in or upon or adjacent to highways, roadways,
trafficways, alleys, sidewalks and parks, within the Township of
East Norriton.

Section 2.

Possession of an open alcoholic and/or malt brew container
by any person as described in the foregoing paragraph shall create
the presumption that such person did consume or intend to consume
the contents thereof in violation of this Ordinance.

Section 3.

Any person who violates the provisions of this Ordinance
shall, upon conviction thereof by summary proceedings, be sentenced
to pay a fine of not more than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) plus
costs, and in default of said fine and costs, to undergo imprison-
ment in Montgomery County Prison for a period not to exceed thirty
(30) days.
