

ORDINANCE NO. 200

TOWNSHIP OF EAST NORRITON  
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 149 AND  
NO. 181 PROVIDING FOR CONTROLLED INTERSECTIONS  
WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST NORRITON BY MAKING  
CERTAIN ADDITIONS AND DELETIONS AS SET FORTH IN  
THE BODY OF THIS ORDINANCE.

The Board of Supervisors of the Township of East  
Norriton, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, under and by virtue of  
the authority granted by the Second-Class Township Code and the  
Motor Vehicle Code do hereby ENACT AND ORDAIN:

1. The following intersections, in addition to those  
authorized under Ordinance No. 149 and Ordinance 181, within the  
Township of East Norriton shall be considered controlled intersections  
and stop signs shall be erected thereon:

Coles and Montgomery  
New Stanbridge and Stanbridge  
Stanbridge and Meadowbrook

2. The following controlled intersections by stop  
signs as authorized under Ordinance No. 149 are deleted and removed  
from Ordinance No. 149:

New Stanbridge and Germantown  
Stoney Creek and Germantown

3. Violation of this Ordinance shall be defined and  
prosecuted pursuant to the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code.
