

ORDINANCE NO. 267  
EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP  
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ANY PERSON, FIRM, CORPORATION, UTILITY, OR OTHER ENTITY PERFORMING WORK ON ANY STATE, COUNTY, OR LOCAL HIGHWAY WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST NORRITON TO FIRST OBTAIN A ROAD OCCUPANCY PERMIT BEFORE COMMENCING SAID WORK.

**WHEREAS**, due to the increased population within the Township and neighboring municipalities, a marked increase in the use of state, county, and local roads has occurred and continues to increase; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township deems it necessary to schedule any work on the state, county, and local highways during non-peak traffic hours so as to minimize any potential detrimental effect on the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Township, in particular, and the motorists, in general.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township under and by virtue of authority granted by the Second Class Township Code, do hereby enact and ordain:

1. No person, firm, corporation, utility, or other entity shall construct upon, cut into, or erect any obstructions upon any state, county, or local highway located within the Township of East Norriton except upon such conditions as set forth below.

2. Any person, firm, corporation, utility, or other entity shall apply to the Police Department of East Norriton Township for a permit on a form prescribed by the Township. The application shall be accompanied by a \$25.00 fee.

3. For the health, safety, and welfare of the public and in particular, the motorists within East Norriton Township, the Police Department may establish specific time frames within which the Applicant shall conduct the work for which the permit was sought. Such time limitation shall be noted on the Permit.

4. A Permit shall be issued to the Applicant after all the aforementioned requirements have been met.

5. Upon completion of the work, the Applicant shall give written notice thereof to the Township.

6. Any person, firm, corporation, utility, or other entity which shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject, upon conviction before District Justice, to pay a fine of not more than Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00) and cost of prosecution. Should any person, firm, corporation, utility, or other entity default in the payment of said fine and costs, that

entity shall be subject to imprisonment in the county jail for not more than five (5) days.
