

ORDINANCE NO. 321

EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP

MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP, SPECIFICALLY, CHAPTER 73 ENTITLED "PLUMBING" BY AMENDING SECTION P-104.2 WHICH REGULATES THE AMOUNT OF SANITARY SEWAGE DISCHARGE REQUIRING PURCHASE OF ADDITIONAL EQUIVALENT DWELLING UNITS (EDU) WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP AND SECTION 1702.1 IS AMENDED BY ADDING PROVISIONS REQUIRING TESTING OF NEW SEWER LINES AND MANHOLES.

The Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania under and by virtue of authority granted by the Second Class Township Code, does hereby enact and ordain:

SECTION 1.

The Code of East Norriton Township, Chapter 73, entitled "Plumbing", Section P-104.2 is hereby amended by deleting existing section P-104.2 and substituting the following:

Any new construction, alteration or change in use which increases the amount of sanitary sewer discharged into East Norriton Township's sewer collection greater than initial amount request shall require additional sewer connection charges to be paid. Each sewer connection charge is based upon on equivalent dwelling unit (EDU) which equals 275 gallons per day flow or any fraction thereof discharged into East Norriton Township's sewer collection system. All new construction, alteration or change in use will be monitored for a period of one year after full occupancy, at the end of which time, additional sewer connection charges per EDU may be assessed. The sewer connection charge for each EDU shall be indicated in a separate resolution adopted by the Board of Supervisors and amended from time to time.

Section 1702.1 is amended by adding:

All new installation, construction or connection of sanitary sewer lines and appurtenances will be required to have closed circuit television inspection to ensure placement true to grade and pressure testing of each joint to guarantee tightness of joints for final approval and acceptance. Any joint failing pressure test or sewer line found not true to design grade must be corrected prior to approval and acceptance. All manholes shall be successfully vacuum tested before final approval and acceptance.

SECTION 2. Severability.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be separate, distinct, and independent and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. Ratification.

This Ordinance shall in no other way affect, amend or modify the Code of East Norriton Township.
