

ORDINANCE NO. 323

## EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP

## MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP, CHAPTER 196 ENTITLED VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, SETTING FORTH TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGN LOCATIONS.

The Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania under and by virtue of authority granted by the Second Class Township Code, does hereby enact and ordain:

SECTION 1.

The East Norriton Township Code is hereby amended as follows:

§196-44. Schedule III: Prohibited Right Turns on Red Signal is hereby amended by adding the following:

NAME OF STREET	DIRECTION OF TRAVEL	PROHIBITED RIGHT TURN ON RED SIGNAL ONTO
Renel Road	West	Arch Road
Old Arch Road	East	Arch Road
Arch Road	South	Old Arch Road
Arch Road	North	Renel Road

Section 196-45. Schedule IV: Prohibited Turns at Intersections is hereby amended by adding the following:

NAME OF STREET	DIRECTION OF TRAVEL	PROHIBITED TURN	HOURS	AT INTERSECTION OF
Norris City Avenue	East	Left	6:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M.	Swede Road

§196-49. Schedule VIII: Stop Intersections is hereby amended by adding the following:

STOP SIGN ON	DIRECTION OF TRAVEL	AT INTERSECTION OF
Hayes Road	East	Polk Road
Hayes Road	West	Polk Road
Evergreen Avenue	West	Hillcrest Avenue
Woodland Avenue	East	James Circle
Woodland Avenue	West	James Circle

Section 196-47. Schedule VII: One-Way Streets is hereby amended by restricting the ingress and egress at the intersections below:

NAME OF STREET	DIRECTION OF TRAVEL	LIMITS
DeKalb Boulevard	South	Must Exit on South side of intersection at DeKalb Pike
DeKalb Boulevard	North	Must Exit on South side of intersection at DeKalb Pike
DeKalb Pike	South	Must Enter on the North side of intersection at DeKalb Boulevard
DeKalb Pike	North	Must Enter on the North side of intersection at DeKalb Boulevard

**SECTION 2. Severability.**

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be separate, distinct, and independent and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 3. Ratification.**

This Ordinance shall in no other way affect, amend or modify the Code of East Norriton Township.
