

ORDINANCE NO. 330

EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP  
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP, SPECIFICALLY, CHAPTER 205, KNOWN AS THE EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE, BY MAKING CERTAIN CHANGES TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE SIGN ORDINANCE DEALING WITH RETAIL ADVERTISING.

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, UNDER AND BY VIRTUE OF THE AUTHORITY GRANTED BY THE SECOND CLASS CODE AND THE MUNICIPALITIES PLANNING CODE, DO HEREBY ENACT AND ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

The Code of East Norriton Township, Chapter 205, known as the East Norriton Township Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended as set forth below.

Amend Section 205-114. Business signs by adding Section D. In an IN-Institutional District, ~~temporary~~ <sup>Seasonal</sup> business signs of up to twenty-four (24) square feet shall be permitted on institutionally zoned property as part of an authorized Township recreational fund raising activity, where approved by the East Norriton Board of Supervisors. <sup>The time period for which the sign may be displayed shall be stated in the sign permit.</sup>

SECTION 2. Severability.

If any Section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of Competent jurisdiction, such provisions shall be separate, distinct and independent, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. Ratification.

This Ordinance shall in no other way affect, amend or modify the said Zoning Ordinance contained in Chapter 205 of the Code of East Norriton Township.
