

ORDINANCE NO. 375

EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP, SPECIFICALLY, CHAPTER 168, STREETS AND SIDEWALKS, TO PROVIDE FOR NO ON-STREET PARKING OF VEHICLES DURING ANY SNOW FALL AND TO INCREASE THE FINE FOR VIOLATING ARTICLE II OF CHAPTER 168 FROM TEN (\$10) DOLLARS TO TWENTY (\$20) DOLLARS.

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA UNDER AND BY VIRTUE OF AUTHORITY GRANTED BY THE SECOND CLASS TOWNSHIP CODE DOES HEREBY ENACT AND ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

The Code of East Norriton Township Code Chapter 168 being the East Norriton Township Streets and Sidewalks Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:

Section 168-9 is hereby deleted and the following is substituted therefore:

Section 168-9. Parking During and After Snowfall and Snow Emergencies.

A. Whenever there shall be any snowfall or if the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, or in his absence or unavailability, any supervisor, shall declare a snow emergency upon snow emergency routes, no on-street parking of vehicles shall be permitted.

B. Anytime a snow emergency shall be deemed to be in effect by virtue of the foregoing provisions, such emergency shall continue to exist until such time as the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, or in his absence or unavailability, any supervisor shall declare that the snow emergency has been terminated.

C. During any snowfall or any snow emergency which has been declared throughout the Township, it shall be unlawful to park any vehicle on any street within the Township until the snow has been completely plowed for the full width of the cartway, except on those streets within the Township where only on-street parking is available. Where only on-street parking is available, all motor vehicles shall be parked on the even-address side of the

street on even-numbered calendar days and on the odd-address side of the street on odd-numbered calendar days.

Section 168-14B is amended by changing the amount of the fine from ten (\$10) dollars to twenty (\$20) dollars.

SECTION 2. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be separate, distinct and independent, and such holdings shall not effect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. Ratification.

This ordinance shall in no other way affect, amend or modify the Code of East Norriton Township.
