

ORDINANCE NO. 376

EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP  
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP, SPECIFICALLY THE EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC ORDINANCE BY INCREASING THE AMOUNTS OF FINES FROM TEN DOLLARS (\$10) FOR PERSONAL VEHICLES AND INCREASING THE FINE FROM FIFTEEN (\$15) TO TWENTY-FIVE (\$25) DOLLARS FOR COMMERCIAL VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT.

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA UNDER AND BY VIRTUE OF THE AUTHORITY GRANTED BY THE SECOND CLASS TOWNSHIP CODE, DOES HEREBY ENACT AND ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

The Code of East Norriton Township Code, Chapter 196, being the East Norriton Township Vehicles and Traffic Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:

Section 196-26 is amended by changing the reference from Fifteen Dollar (\$15) fines to Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25) throughout that section and by changing the fines reflected as Ten Dollars (\$10) to Twenty Dollars (\$20) throughout that section.


SECTION 2. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be separate, distinct and independent, and such holdings shall not effect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. Ratification.

This ordinance shall in no other way affect, amend or modify the Chapter 196 of the Code of East Norriton Township.
