

ORDINANCE NO. 470

EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 445 BY
INCREASING THE SEWAGE COLLECTION AND BOND CHARGES
FOR BOTH METERED AND NON-METERED WATER USERS.

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, duly enacted Ordinance No. 445 on January 6, 2003, an ordinance imposing, inter alia, sewer rentals or charges for the use of the sewers and sewer system in the township, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township deems it necessary and intends to further amend Section 4, subparagraphs (a) and (b) of Ordinance No. 445, as amended; and

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township hereby ordains and enacts that;

Section 1. Section 4, subparagraphs (a) and (b) of Ordinance No. 445 are hereby repealed and deleted in their entirety, and a new Section 4, Subparagraphs (a) and (b) are hereby added to read as follows:

Section 4. Rentals or Rates for Sanitary Sewers:

(a) Rates for Metered Water Users:

All persons owning property connecting to the sewer system and served with metered water service shall pay a quarterly rental for sanitary sewage service based on quantity of water used, as evidenced by meter readings of water meters installed and maintained by the water supplier for the purpose of measuring water purchased from said water supplier and such other meters as may be installed pursuant to any provisions of this ordinance, and subject to the minimum charges hereinafter provided all as follows:

i) Sewage Collection Charge (which will apply to all quantities of water consumed):

(a) These rates are effective for the billing of March 31, 2005 (for water consumed August 2004 through November 2004)

<u>First</u>	7,000 gallons or less per quarter	\$14.82 per quarter minimum
<u>Next</u>	53,000 gallons per quarter	\$1.06 per 1,000 gallons per quarter
<u>All Over</u>	60,000 gallons per quarter	\$0.75 per 1,000 gallons per quarter

ii) Sewage Treatment Charge (which will apply to all quantities of water consumed):

(a) These rates are effective for the billing of March 31, 2005 (for water consumed August 2004 through November 2004)

<u>First</u>	7,000 gallons or less per quarter	\$34.52 per quarter minimum
<u>Next</u>	53,000 gallons per quarter	\$2.00 per 1,000 gallons per quarter
<u>All Over</u>	60,000 gallons per quarter	\$1.68 per 1,000 gallons per quarter

iii) Bond Charge (which will apply to all quantities of water consumed):

(a) These rates are effective for the billing of March 31, 2005 (for water consumed August 2004 through November 2004)

<u>First</u>	7,000 gallons or less per quarter	\$15.31 per quarter minimum
<u>Next</u>	53,000 gallons per quarter	\$1.07 per 1,000 gallons per quarter
<u>All Over</u>	60,000 gallons per quarter	\$0.76 per 1,000 gallons per quarter

(b) Rates for Non-Metered Water Users:

All domestic users owning property connecting to the Sewer System and served with water service, all of which water service is unmetered, shall pay a quarterly rental of sanitary sewage service as follows:

i) Sewage Collection Charge:

- (a) effective for the billing of March 31, 2005 (for water consumed August 2004 through November 2004)
\$24.33 per quarter

ii) Sewage Treatment Charge:

- (a) effective for the billing of March 31, 2005 (for water consumed August 2004 through November 2004)
\$51.79 per quarter

iii) Bond Charge:

- (a) effective for the billing of March 31, 2003 (for water consumed August 2002 through November 2002)
\$24.35 per quarter

The township reserves the right to enter into separate contracts for the collection and treatment of sanitary sewage from unmetered commercial, public and industrial users."

Section 2. All other terms and provisions of Ordinance No. 31 are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. The proper officers of the township are hereby authorized and empowered on behalf of the Township to execute any and all papers and documents and to do or cause to be done any and all acts and things necessary or proper for the carrying out of this ordinance.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 5. These rates are effective for the billing of March 31, 2005 (for water consumed August 2004 through November 2004) and thereafter.
