

**ORDINANCE NO. 509
EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

**AN ORDINANCE OF EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP AMENDING THE CODE OF
THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST NORRITON BY AMENDING CHAPTER 162, SEWERS,
TO REVISE TOWNSHIP STANDARDS REGULATING MANHOLE CONNECTIONS.**

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 393, the Township adopted the "Construction Requirements for Sanitary Sewers and Appurtenances and Detail Drawings for East Norriton Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, February 1998" ("Appendix A") to establish the standards for sanitary sewer construction in the Township;

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township (the "Board") finds it advisable and necessary to amend Appendix A to revise the standards governing manhole connections;

WHEREAS, the Board deems it to be in the best interest and the general welfare of the citizens and residents of the Township to adopt new standards for manhole connections; and,

WHEREAS, the Board has met the procedural requirements of the Second Class Township Code for the adoption of the proposed ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same as follows:

SECTION I. AMENDMENT OF CODE

The code of East Norriton Township, Chapter 162, Appendix A, is hereby amended by adding the following:

1). The use of a Kor-N-Seal flexible connector for sewer connections to existing manholes is hereby permitted. Such connection must conform to detail DM-05A, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A" and which is hereby made a part of Appendix A.

2). Any developer or property owner submitting a design plan proposing a connection to an existing brick manhole shall be required to remove the existing brick manhole and replace it with a new precast concrete manhole.

SECTION II. REVISIONS

The Board does hereby reserve the right, from time to time, to adopt modifications of, supplements to, or amendments of its ordinances and hereby authorizes any future changes to Appendix A to be done by a resolution of the Board.

SECTION III. REPEALER

All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, it being understood and intended that all ordinances and the Code of the Township of East Norriton

Pennsylvania, such as are not otherwise specifically in conflict or inconsistent with this ordinance, shall remain in full force and effect, the same being reaffirmed hereby.

SECTION IV. SEVERABILITY

If any sentence, clause, section, term, phrase or part of this ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, terms, provisions, or parts of this ordinance. It is hereby declared the intent of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of East Norriton that this ordinance would have been adopted had such an unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section, or part thereof not been included herein.

SECTION V. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days after enactment.

SECTION VI. FAILURE TO ENFORCE

The failure of East Norriton Township to enforce any provision of this ordinance shall not constitute a waiver by East Norriton Township of its rights of future enforcement hereunder.


